REPRESENTATIVE MATTERS

- In Fall 2012, Mr. Jones obtained a verdict in a medical malpractice case in Western Tennessee in excess of \$800,000, *Hutcherson v. Dr. Caylor*.
- In January 2013, Mr. Jones and Tannera Gibson represented a plaintiff in obtaining a verdict in a medical malpractice case in Shelby County for more than \$1.3 Million Dollars, *Martin v. Campbell Clinic*.
- In February, 2015, Mr. Jones, Tannera Gibson and David Goodman represented a plaintiff in obtaining a verdict in a medical malpractice case in Shelby County for \$750,000.00, *Smith v. UTMG*.
